یک گروه هکری به نام «قیام تا سرنگونی» با انتشار تصویری از کارت عضویت «بسیج» #امیر_عبداللهیان وزیر امور خارجه دولت سیزدهم جمهوری اسلامی از «رخنه به وبسایت‌های #وزارت_خارجه_ایران» خبر داده است.

این خبر در حالی منتشر شده که امروز یکشنبه ۱۷ اردیبهشت‌ماه ۱۴۰۲ پایگاه‌های اینترنتی وزارت خارجه ایران از دسترس خارج شده و پیام «به‌روزرسانی سامانه» بر روی آنها منتشر شده است.

گروه هکری موسوم به «قیام تا سرنگونی» علاوه بر اعلام خبر نفوذ به پایگاه‌های اینترنتی وزارت امور خارجه بخشی از اسناد این وزارتخانه، از جمله اطلاعات شخصی مدیران ارشد و یازده هزار تن از کارکنان این نهاد را منتشر کرده است.

این گروه هکری همچنین مدعی شده است که شمار پایگاه‌های وزارت امور خارجه که از دسترس خارج شده است ۲۱۰ سایت و سامانه است. گروه هکری «قیام تا سرنگونی» همچنین ادعا کرده که اسنادی چون فهرست کارمندان وزارت خارجه و نمایندگی‌های جمهوری اسلامی در تمام کشورها را هک کرده است.

از آغاز جنبش اجتماعی «زن، زندگی، آزادی» تاکنون بسیاری از سایت‌ها و سامانه‌های دولتی در ایران مورد حمله هکری گروه‌های مختلف قرار گرفته‌اند.

در یکی از نمونه‌های نفوذ در ۱۶ مهرماه ۱۴۰۱ در میانه سخنرانی رهبر جمهوری اسلامی شبکه خبر صدا و سیما حکومتی مورد حمله هکری قرار گرفت و به جای تصاویر و سخنان علی خامنه‌ای، شعار زن، زندگی، آزادی پخش شد.

در لحظاتی که شبکه خبر هک شد، علاوه بر شعار زن، زندگی، آزادی، بر روی صفحه تلویزیون، تصویری از علی خامنه‌ای که در آتش می‌سوزد به «نمایش درآمد که در کنارش نوشته شده بود: «چوپان دروغگو اعتراضات_سراسری #اعتصابات_سراسری #مهسا_امینی»

A hacking group called "Rise to Overthrow" published an image of the Basij membership card #وزارت_خارجه_ایران. The Minister of Foreign Affairs of the 13th Islamic Republic has informed the "Stop" website of #امیر_عبداللهیان.

This news was published while today, Sunday, May 15, 1398, the Iranian Foreign Ministry internet stations were out of service and the message of "update the system" was published on them.

In addition to announcing the infiltration of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the hacking group called "rise to the overthrow" has published some of the ministry's documents, including the personal information of senior managers and eleven thousand employees of the institution.

The hacking group also claimed that the number of State Department bases that have been out of reach is 1,300 sites and systems.

The "Rise to Overthrow" hacking group also claimed to have hacked documents such as the list of Foreign Ministry employees and Islamic Republic agencies in all countries.

Since the beginning of the social movement "Women, Life, Freedom" so far, many websites and government systems in Iran have been hacked by various groups.

In one of the examples of influence, on October 16, 1971, during the speech of the leader of the Islamic Republic, the government TV and TV News Network was hacked and instead of Ali Khamenei's pictures and words, the slogan of Woman, Life, Freedom was broadcasted.

In the moments when the news network was hacked, in addition to the chants of women, life, freedom, on the TV screen, a picture of Ali Khamenei burning in fire was shown with the words next to it: "Liar Shepherd".

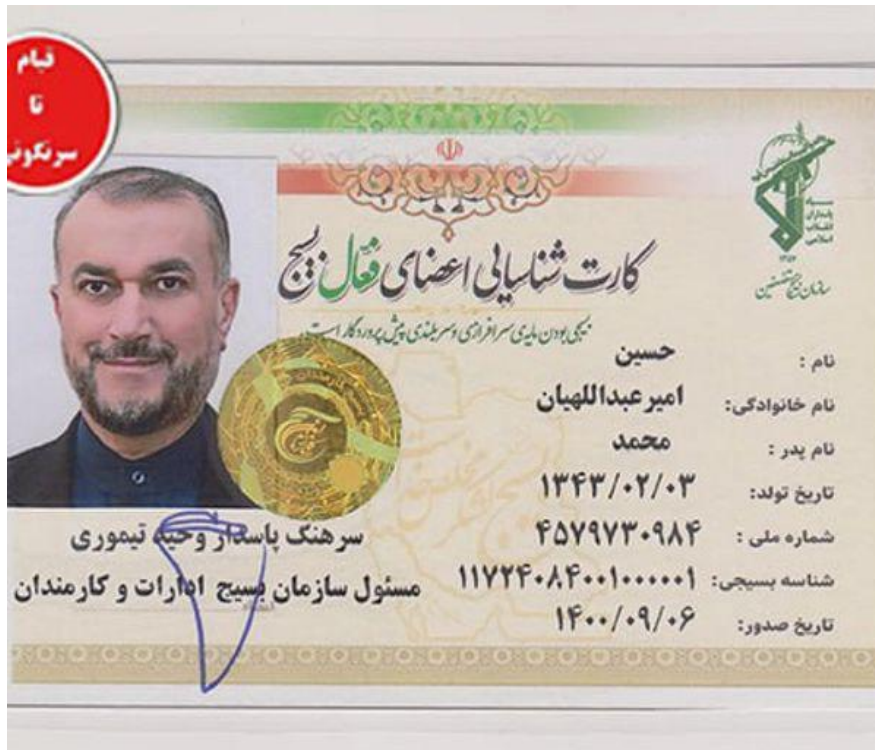

Hacktivists Target Iran's Foreign Ministry, Leak Trove Of Data

An Iranian group has hacked into the Islamic Republic's foreign ministry servers, disabling 210 sites and online services and leaking a large batch of documents.

The hacktivist group 'Uprising till Overthrow', affiliated with the Albania-based opposition Mujahideen-e Khalq (MEK) group, released hundreds of identification documents, minutes of meetings, the ministry's correspondence, phone numbers of ministry officials, and the names of 11,000 employees of the foreign ministry, among others.

A sample of the leaked documents

According to the telegram channel of the hackers, all the sites related to the ministry such as the Islamic Republic's embassies, and affiliated organizations were targeted, showing a landing page with photos of the leaders of MEK as well as photos of Iran's Supreme Leader Ali Khamenei and President Raisi with red crosses over them.

Also on the page, there were slogans of "Death to Khamenei" and "Hail to Rajavi", the current leader of the opposition group. "There is a great revolution underway in Iran. The uprising will continue until the palace of oppression is demolished. Iran's democratic revolution will be victorious," read the message on the pages. Most of the pages were down midday on Sunday.

The 'Uprising till Overthrow' had already hacked and deactivated several regime's websites and services. In June 2022, it **hacked over 5,000 security cameras of state bodies** and 150 websites belonging to Tehran Municipality, displaying similar slogans on the websites and releasing internal data.

The hack comes after another **cyberassault in March on the portal of the Ministry of Culture and Islamic Guidance** (Ershad) and its affiliated websites showing the photos of the Rajavis and calling for the death of the country's supreme leader.

The documents leaked on Sunday also revealed the Islamic Republic's continuous efforts and correspondence with European officials to finalize a prisoner swap deal with Belgium, which would see jailed Iranian diplomat Asadollah Assadi released in exchange for the detained Belgian aid worker Olivier Vandecasteele.

The Belgian Constitutional Court upheld a prisoner exchange treaty with Iran in March that could result in Assadi being swapped for Vandecasteele. The MEK mounted a fierce campaign against the deal, challenging the extradition.

Former Iranian embassy attaché, Asadollah Asadi, 51, is currently serving a 20-year sentence in Belgium for alleged attempted murder and involvement in terrorism for his role in plotting a bomb attack during an MEK event near Paris in 2018. Asadi, the only Iranian diplomat ever brought to trial in Europe for direct involvement in terrorism was arrested in Germany, where he did not enjoy diplomatic immunity while he was on holiday. German authorities later extradited Assadi to Belgium. He was a diplomat in Iran's embassy in Austria.

Security forces in Iran arrested aid worker Olivier Vandecasteele, 41, who has worked in a variety of humanitarian agencies since at least 2006. In January, the Islamic Republic's judiciary sentenced **Vandecasteele**, who was detained in 2022, to 40 years in prison and 74 lashes for alleged "spying and cooperation with the United States, money laundering and smuggling \$500,000 out of Iran."

Iran has been accused of wrongfully detaining at least a dozen foreign and dual nationals on trumped up charges, effectively as hostages to extract concessions from Western governments. Most of them are held on spurious spying charges.

Hossein Amir-Abdollahian (Persian: حسین امیرعبداللهیان; born 1964) is an Iranian politician, diplomat and current foreign minister of Iran.^[1] He was formerly the deputy foreign minister for Arab and African Affairs from 2011 to 2016.^[1]

He was special aide to the speaker of the Iranian Parliament on international affairs, Director General of International Affairs of the Islamic Consultative Assembly from the presidency of Ali Larijani to the presidency of Mohammad Bagher Ghalibaf, Secretary-General of the Permanent Secretariat of the International Conference in Support of the Palestinian Intifada, Managing Director of Palestine Strategic Dialogue Quarterly.^{[2][3][4]}

He is a well-known figure in the State Department, and his outspoken and active international and regional stance has highlighted him in the crises of Iraq, Syria, and developments in West Asia and North Africa.^[5] He holds a Ph.D. from Tehran University in international relations.

He was appointed Deputy Foreign Minister during the ministry of Ali Akbar Salehi, which was retained in the first three years of Mohammad Javad Zarif's ministry. He is currently professor at the State Department's School of International Relations.^[6]

After the implicit resignation of Zarif, the name of Amirabdollahian was mentioned by some media outlets as one of the candidates for the post of minister, who was close to Ali Larijani, the speaker of the then Iranian parliament.^[7]

Early life and education

Amirabdollahian was born in 1964 in Damghan. At the age of 6-7, he lost his father. He was married in 1994 and has a son and a daughter. He holds a Ph.D. from Tehran University in international relations and is said to be fluent in Arabic and English,^[7] However he can not speak English.

Affiliation

Amirabdollahian's positions are more reflective of Seyyed Ali Khamenei and do not fit in clearly within either reformists or fundamentalist trends in the Iranian political discourse. Some of his stances are in a way that supports the so-called Resistance Front, which is affiliated with Hezbollah in Lebanon, Syria, and other currents aligned with the Islamic Republic of Iran that are in conflict with Israel.^[8]

He was a member of the Political and Security Committee of the Nuclear Negotiations during the nuclear talks during the presidency of Seyyed Mohammad Khatami. He is the first Iranian official to be invited to London for regional talks after the reopening of the London embassy in Tehran during Hassan Rouhani's first term, and to meet with then-British Foreign Secretary Philip Hammond. He has detailed regional talks with Federica Mogherini on his file, and has had detailed meetings with UN Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon and Hezbollah-Lebanon Secretary-General Seyed Hassan Nasrallah.^[9]

Negotiation with the United States

He was the head of the Iranian negotiating team at the Iran-Iraq-US trilateral meeting in Baghdad in 2007. The meeting was held to secure Iraq at the request of the Americans, who called the situation in Iraq dangerous. The talks failed after three sessions without result. Amirabdollahian later said of the talks that the Americans left the scene when they heard a logical word and did not have a logical answer. At the beginning of the US negotiations, they thought that they should set the agenda, but the Islamic Republic did not allow them to do so, and it was decided that the agenda should be set by agreement of the parties.^{[10][11]}

Communication with Qasem Soleimani

He had a close relationship with Qasem Soleimani, and this was due to two decades of responsibility in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, especially in the Arab and African positions of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Iran. When Soleimani became commander of the Quds Force, Amirabdollahian was an Iraqi expert at the Foreign Ministry. During the US invasion of Iraq in 2003, with the overthrow of Saddam, he became in charge of Iraq at the State Department.

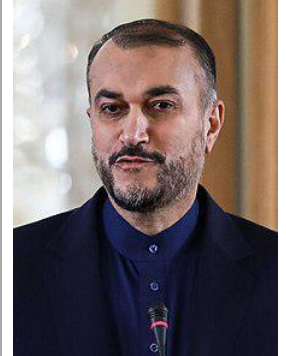
Amirabdollahian later during a meeting with European delegations and officials said that you should thank the Islamic Republic and Soleimani because Soleimani has contributed to world peace and security. He believes that without Soleimani, the major countries in the region would have disintegrated.^[12]
