Is this another Mahsa Jina Amini?

A 16-year-old Iranian girl, Armita Geravand, fell into a coma after reportedly being assaulted by hijab enforcement officers, also known as the “morality police,” in a subway station in Tehran.

She was admitted to Fajr Air Force Hospital in Tehran on Sunday, October 1, reportedly with “head trauma and visible head injuries.”

What exactly happened to Armita and her current situation is still unclear as **authorities have increased security around the hospital.**

“Today [October 6], they even canceled all visitation in the ICU ward on the first floor and kept everyone on the ground floor,” a source told Radio Zamaneh.

Armita’s case unfolds just over a year after Mahsa Jina Amini’s killing by “morality officers,” which authorities tried to cover up with claims of previous health conditions.

Armita is an art student from a working-class neighborhood in western Tehran with a passion for painting and semi-professionally trained in taekwondo.

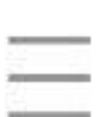

Missing Video Footage

Authorities released CCTV footage, which appeared to have been edited, showing Armita and her female friends entering a subway car without headscarves.

Soon after, one of her friends quickly stepped out and reached for the ground, while Armita was pulled out unconscious with the assistance of other passengers.

Eyewitnesses and rights groups allege that she fell during a confrontation with “morality officers” for not wearing the mandatory hijab. However, authorities have refuted such claims, asserting that she “fainted due to a drop in blood pressure.”

No video from inside the subway has been released yet. Activists have also pointed out that some clips are missing from the CCTV footage released by the authorities.

Witnesses Recount the Incident

According to IranWire, eyewitnesses saw Armita and two friends confronted by agents at the Shohada metro station who demanded that they wear headscarves and allegedly pushed one of the girls.

A witness also told the Guardian that after Armita entered the carriage, a female hijab enforcer started arguing with her because she wasn't wearing a headscarf.

“The chador-clad woman screamed at her, asking her why she was not covered. Armita then told her, ‘Do I ask you to remove your headscarf? Why are you asking me to wear one?’ Their argument then turned violent. The hijab enforcer started physically attacking Armita and ... violently pushed her.”

Another source told Radio Zamaneh that Armita and two of her friends had an argument with officers who warned them to wear headscarves, and they pushed Armita, resulting in her head hitting a metal object.

Armita's Parents on State Television

The Islamic Republic News Agency IRNA published an interview on October 3 with Armita's parents, who have reportedly been allowed to see their daughter only a few times from behind windows.

"I don't know what. I think they say that her blood pressure dropped, then she fell down, and her head hit the edge of the metro," Armita's mother said, stumbling on her words as her voice shook.

Armita's father, Ahmad Geravand, looked down with folded arms. He said his daughter had been healthy and not on any medications.

Many observers have described the interview as a "forced confession." Sources told IranWire that **the family is under heavy pressure from security agencies to follow the State's version of the incident.**

Armita's Mother Arrested

Armita's mother, Shahin Ahmadi, was arrested on October 4 near Fajr Hospital, where her daughter is receiving medical attention, according to the Hengaw human rights organization.

Reportedly, she was taken to an undisclosed location, and security forces have warned her family not to publicize the news of her arrest.

In another interview with State Television, Ahmadi **complained that her family had yet to see all the CCTV footage** from the metro station where the incident occurred.

Heavy Security Presence Around the Hospital and Armita's Family

On October 4, the Hengaw human rights organization, which shared a photo of Armita in her hospital bed, reported that security agents had confiscated the mobile phones of her family members.

Radio Farda also reported the presence of plainclothes officers in the hospital's intensive care unit.

Journalist Samira Rahi posted a photograph showing the presence of law enforcement personnel stationed outside Fajr Hospital, where Armita is currently in a coma.

"Two police cars are positioned at the entrance to the emergency room of Fajr Hospital, and the presence of plainclothes officers is evident," she wrote on X, citing an informed source.

The journalist further reported that "security forces have been inspecting the vehicles passing through this area and, in some instances, have been scrutinizing the content of the passengers' cell phones."

Pressure on Classmates and Teachers

Authorities have applied immense pressure on Armita's teachers and classmates to control the narrative around the incident that led to her hospitalization.

"Today, the Ministry of Education's Security Director visited Armita Geravand's school and threatened her teachers. He emphasized that sharing **any news or photos of Armita Geravand on social media by her teachers would result in heavy fines** and the immediate termination of their contracts," the Coordination Council of Iran Educators said on October 4.

It also added that Armita's classmates were coerced into appearing in front of cameras to deny that she had been assaulted by officers.

On October 2, the Council said that the Security Director of Tehran's Education Directorate also threatened the teachers and students against "sharing any information" about Armita's condition.

While the reactions to the condition and unconsciousness of Armita Ground continue and the citizens show their support for this teenage girl by writing on the wall and putting up a protest banner, the United Nations Human Rights Council .announced that the fact-finding committee will investigate the "reported attack on her". he does

The mother of Mohammad Hassan Turkman, a protester killed in the revolutionary uprising of Iranians against the Islamic Republic, published a photo of Armita Gravand on Saturday, October 15, and wrote: "My dear, come back to life and stay." Stay and fight for your rights with all your strength and courage. Stay and portray humanity beautifully... stay ".and fight, stay and be strong for who you are, stay, you just stay

On the other hand, the citizens of Tehran hung a banner in support of this 16-year-old girl, who is said to have gone into a . " coma due to an assault for not observing the mandatory hijab, which read: "Tehran in a coma

.A video has also been published of Izeh, which shows that school students have written Armita's name on their chairs

The continuation of reactions and support for Armita Ground is in a situation where there is no new information about her condition in the hospital

Hengaw site reported on Saturday noon that the security authorities continuously control the CCTV cameras of Fajr Military Hospital, which used to be under the authority of the army's protection pillar, and at the end of the day erase the memory of the cameras

Armita was transferred to Fajr Hospital, which is affiliated to the Air Force of the Islamic Republic of Iran, after fainting at Tehran's Shahadai subway station on Sunday morning, the 9th of Mehr, and since then, her place of detention has been surrounded by security forces

Some eyewitnesses have confirmed in the past days that he fainted and went into a coma due to the physical violence of a tent woman, whom some have identified as "government-affiliated arsonist" and others as "a hijab-wearing agent

The reaction of the UN fact-finding committee and Amnesty International

In the same context, the United Nations Human Rights Council wrote, quoting the Independent Fact-Finding Committee about Iran: "We are investigating the reported attack on 16-year-old Armita Ground for not complying with the mandatory hijab rules, one year after the death of Zina Mehsa Amini in custody. "Women's right to equality must be respected

Amnesty International also announced that the international community should ask the Iranian authorities to allow an independent international delegation, including UN experts, to investigate the circumstances that led to the unconsciousness and hospitalization of Armita Gravand (following reports about her attack by officers wearing the mandatory hijab). to enter Iran

Iranian authorities have launched a concerted campaign of denial and distortion to cover up the truth about the circumstances that led to the unconsciousness of Armita Ground," said Diana al-Tahavi, deputy regional director for the Middle East and North Africa at Amnesty International

He noted that this incident is eerily reminiscent of the fake narratives and their unacceptable explanations of Mehssa Gina Amini's hospitalization about a year ago

Josep Burrell, the head of the European Union's foreign policy, also said in response to the question of the Iran International reporter in Berlin: "We are aware of the reports about the deterioration of the condition of Armita Gravand, who is hospitalized in one of the hospitals in Tehran, and we are following up on this worrying case

In response to the question of the reporter of Iran International, the European Union foreign policy official said that the reports indicate that the situation that happened to Armita Gerwand was the result of a conflict with the hijab control officers

.He emphasized that in case of final approval, this will be unacceptable and unjustifiable

On the other hand, according to the information received by Iran International, Shaheen Ahmadi, the mother of Armita Gravand, was released from detention before noon on Friday, 14 Mehr, under the condition of silence and not talking to people and the media

The parents of this teenage girl managed to see her from behind the glass for a few minutes in the presence of the security agents for the last time at noon on Wednesday, October 12, and after that they were not even allowed to see her again

.Shaheen Ahmadi was arrested for protesting the same issue

After the officers prevented him from being in the room where his daughter is admitted, he shouted and protested and the security officers stationed at the hospital arrested him

The Judiciary Information Center and the Tasnim Security Agency denied this news, but despite getting the news of her release from reliable sources, it is not possible for independent sources to access Armita Ground's mother

On the other hand, exclusive information received by Iran International about Armita's condition indicates that security agents are present at all stages of her treatment and visits, and the doctors and nurses who go to her room are constantly searched for their mobile phones or cameras. Do not have

Also, based on the information obtained, the security agents said that Armita's doctor and nurses should be stable and "unchanging people to reduce the possibility of "leaking news about her condition

The surveillance cameras in the room where this teenage girl is hospitalized have also been cut off to prevent hacking or "leaking images, and she has a "permanent caretaker

However, Iran's Didehban site reported that the site of Fajr Hospital, which belongs to the Air Force, where Armita . "Gerwand is hospitalized, has disabled access to the two links "Hospital Wards" and "Acquaintance with the Hospital

Iran Watch contacted Fajr Hospital to investigate why the access to the link of the hospital's departments was restricted .in the last two days, but did not receive a response

The large presence of security agents in the hospital and its surrounding area is still maintained, and at the same time, . "since the evening of Thursday 13 Mehr, a large number of anti-riot forces have entered Fajr hospital with "ambulance

The information received by Iran International about Armita's health condition also indicates that she is still in a coma .without any signs of recovery and there is concern about her condition

On Thursday , [the Guardian wrote in a report](#) quoting an eyewitness that one of the hijab officer's women "pushed Armita .hard" after entering the subway car because she did not wear the mandatory hijab

An eyewitness also told the Guardian that shortly after Armita entered the subway car on the 9th of Mehr, a chador .woman and the leader of the mandatory hijab started arguing with her for not covering her hair

According to this [report](#) , the woman shouted to Armita why she was not wearing a headscarf (mask) and this teenage "?girl replied: "Am I asking you to take off your veil

Later, the argument between the two turned violent and the hijab-ban woman physically attacked Armita and pushed her .hard

.Another eyewitness told the Guardian that Armita was "still conscious" when she fell to the ground

The Guardian also addressed the talks of the opposition of the Islamic Republic about the government's lies and .propaganda about Armita and what happened to him in the subway

Referring to the news published about the arrest of Shaheen Ahmadi, Armita's mother, and the denial of it by the IRGC-affiliated media and the government, this report said that this arrest shows that the authorities of the Islamic Republic . .fear that she did not believe the official story about what happened to her daughter

Earlier, Iran International received information that Armita Gravand's mother has been detained since Wednesday .evening

Five days after Armita Ground went into a coma on the 9th of Mehr, the reactions in Iran and the world about the possibility of her being assaulted by agents known as Hijabban continue. Videos released from Iran show citizens writing Armita's name on the walls and comparing her fate with Mehsa Gina Amini

One of these videos is related to the evening of 12th Mehr, of a protest banner in Karaj that reads: "Armita Ground is another month

In a letter, imprisoned human rights activist Narges Mohammadi described the government's behavior in dealing with the issue of this teenage girl as a sign of a "rushed effort" to "prevent the truth from being revealed

According to him, the arrest of the journalist following this story, the ambiguous interview of IRNA with Armita's parents, the pressure of friends accompanying this teenage girl and the siege of the hospital by the security forces are examples of contradictory and highly security-controlled behaviors

The spokesperson of the Human Rights Defenders Center called on the whole world not to remain silent in the face of
 . "this incident "as a human being

In contrast to the numerous supportive reactions that have been formed for this teenage girl, the media and figures
 .affiliated with the government are creating new cases for the journalists who reported on Armita's fainting story

One of the users known as "Arzashi" on X social network claimed that the activity of "domestic spies-journalists in
 .producing riots" has a specific pattern

By accusing Maryam Lotfi, a journalist of Sharq in Fajr Hospital and her interview with Armita's mother, he compared it to
 the coverage of the news related to the government murder of Mahsa Zina Amini by Niloufer Hamed and Elaha
 Mohammadi and once again called them "spy-reporter". called

Ignorance of Armita's condition and deletion of her father's interview

There is no accurate information available about Armita Ground's condition in the hospital and it seems that her family is
 .also unaware of her condition in Fajr Military Hospital belonging to the Air Force

Faraz online newspaper published an interview with Ahmed Gravand, Armita's father, which was soon removed from the
 .outlet of this media

Maziar Khosravi, the editor of this online newspaper, wrote on the X social network explaining the removal of this report:
 ".In the news that quoted Armita Ground's father, there was a big mistake and it led to wrong information

Armita's father said in this interview: "Actually, I don't know much about Armita's condition. I am not in the hospital. I am
 at work. I haven't heard from Armita for several days. I'm not in the loop. As far as I know, he is in a coma. That's all I
 ".know

Armita is hospitalized in Fajr Military Hospital, which belongs to the Air Force of the Islamic Republic of Iran and is
 .surrounded by security forces

Although this hospital is relatively close to the place where Armita fainted in Maidan Shahada metro station, but apart
 .from this hospital, there were at least two hospitals closer to the accident site (Shefa Yahyaian and Meiri)

Government news agencies in Iran quoted Ismail Farahani, the deputy of emergency operations of Tehran province,
 about the reason why Armita was transferred to Fajr Hospital and wrote: "The most suitable treatment center is not the
 ".nearest hospital

Farahani claimed that Fajar Hospital was a more suitable option for Armita because it has general surgery and
 .neurosurgery departments

Ambiguity in the videos attributed to Armita inside the metro station

.Ambiguity and doubt about the story of Armita Ground is not limited only to the place of her hospitalization

On Wednesday, a video of this teenager's presence in the Tehran subway was published, which, according to the
 .government's claim, is related to all the moments of his arrival at the Shahada station until he entered the train

In this video, however, there is no information about the pictures inside the wagon and the events that may have
 .happened there

In addition, social media users pointed out the cutting and deletion of minutes from these videos and even raised the possibility that the girl in the videos could not be Armita

Some users also mentioned that Shahada metro station is Armita's usual route to go to school, and it is possible that the published video is related to another day; Because it seems that the details of the clothing of this teenage girl do not match the moment she fainted

Published reports about threats and pressure on Armita's friends, classmates, and the teenage girl's family have fueled doubts about the government's dubious narrative about the incident

The Coordinating Council of Cultural Organizations of Iran reported that on October 12, the head of security of the Ministry of Education appeared at "Urwa-ul-Wagghi" high school, where Armita Ground is studying, and threatened her teachers and classmates

According to this report, they were told that publishing any news or even a photo of Armita on virtual pages will result in a heavy fine and the wrongdoer will be fired

Tehran's reaction to Western countries' concern about Armita

In the past days, a number of officials from Western countries such as America, Great Britain, Germany and Australia . have commented and expressed concern about Armita Ground and her assault due to the mandatory hijab

In response, Nasser Kanani, the spokesman of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Islamic Republic on Thursday, 13 Mehr, called the Western countries' concern about the situation of Iranian women "interventionist, biased and .dishonest

He wrote on the X social network: "It is better to worry about the American, German and British healthcare personnel and ".the patients and take care of their condition

One of these comments was made by Michelle Taylor, the US ambassador to the UN Human Rights Council, who pointed out her country's support for the statement of a group of countries in the meeting of this council against the approval of .the "Hijab and Chastity" law in the Iranian parliament

Emphasizing that this law worsens the current difficult conditions of Iranian women, he noted: "The imposition of heavy ".punishment and economic blockade against women who do not observe the mandatory hijab is unacceptable

Taylor asked the Islamic Republic to pay attention to the legitimate demands of the protesters and adhere to its .international obligations

Before him, [Abram Paley, the deputy US special representative for Iran affairs](#) , called the published reports about Armita Ground "shocking" and while expressing concern, he said that Washington is following the news about Armita's .condition

The reaction of the world's media to the tragedy of Armita

In addition to political officials, Armita Gravand's coma due to a possible attack by government agents in Iran has had a .wide coverage in the world's media over the past few days

CNN addressed this issue in a report on Thursday and wrote that Iranian human rights activists blame the Islamic Republic for the fainting of this teenage girl due to not observing the mandatory hijab

This news agency also republished the interview of Shaheen Ahmadi, mother and Ahmed Gravand, father of Armita, with the state news agency IRNA, with the same stuttering and confusion in the video, and the possibility of this interview "being "forced

In a video published on October 11, Armita's mother said: "I think he fell... I think they said he was stressed, fell to the "...ground, his head hit the edge of the subway and his friends took him out

In another part of its report, CNN has mentioned the pressure of the Islamic Republic on the families of the killed protesters to force confession and support the government's desired narrative

.France 24 also published a report on October 13 that shocked Iran about Armita Gravand's coma

Covering the news related to the fainting of this teenage girl, this news agency reminded that the human rights groups have pointed the finger of accusation towards the Islamic Republic and its agents

Before that, the French magazine Le Poin had written in a report while pointing out the haste of the Iranian media in denying the clash in the subway, that the arrest of the journalist in the hospital shows the "extraordinary sensitivity" of

.this issue

This magazine refers to the detention of Maryam Lotfi, a reporter of Shargh newspaper, for several hours on the 10th of Mehr while interviewing Armita's mother in the hospital

.Officials are on standby to prevent protests in the event of his death," Le Poyne added in his report"

In addition to Europe, in Asia, the media in Taiwan, Malaysia, Indonesia, Singapore, and Thailand reflected the issue of Armita Ground's fainting and state violence against her due to not wearing the mandatory hijab

In the South Korean media, this issue was covered in a relatively wide way, from the state news agency Yonhap and the Hankyoreh newspaper to the KBS TV channel

These media often reported on the human rights media and the Iranian people's distrust of the official statements of the Islamic Republic about the cause of Armita Ground's coma

They also raised the question whether this incident will lead to the formation of other protests like the one that happened after the killing of Mehsa Gina Amini

Armita, who is said to be a student who loves painting and is a professional taekwondo practitioner, was unconscious in a subway car at Shahada station in Tehran on October 9 and was taken to Fajr Military Hospital in the presence of emergency forces

.According to some reports, this teenage girl is now in a coma due to brain hemorrhage

New details emerge as 16-year-old Armita Geravand is fighting for her life

New details have emerged as 16-year-old Armita Geravand is fighting for her

16-year-old Armita Geravand is still [in a coma](#) after being brutally assaulted by a Hijab enforcer early Sunday morning, October 1, 2023. Her condition has not improved.

Armita's family is under severe security pressure and they are not allowed to visit their daughter. Her parents and friends are silenced, and banned from reaching out to reporters.

Intelligence services have even visited Armita's high school and intimidated the students, ordering them to stay away from news outlets.

Her mother [was violently arrested](#) on October 4, allegedly after attempting to enter the ICU to see her child.

The 16-year-old Armita Geravand and a couple of her friends boarded a train at Tehran's Shohada Metro Station. Two witnesses have told [The Guardian](#) that there was an altercation, which led to Armita's cerebral hemorrhage and loss of consciousness.

Excerpts from The Guardian:

A witness claimed that soon after Armita entered the carriage a female hijab enforcer started arguing with her because she wasn't wearing a headscarf. "The chador-clad woman screamed at her asking her why was she not covered," the witness told [the Guardian](#). "Armita then told her 'Do I ask you to remove your headscarf? Why are you asking me to wear one?' Their argument then turned violent. The hijab enforcer started physically attacking Armita and ... violently pushed her."



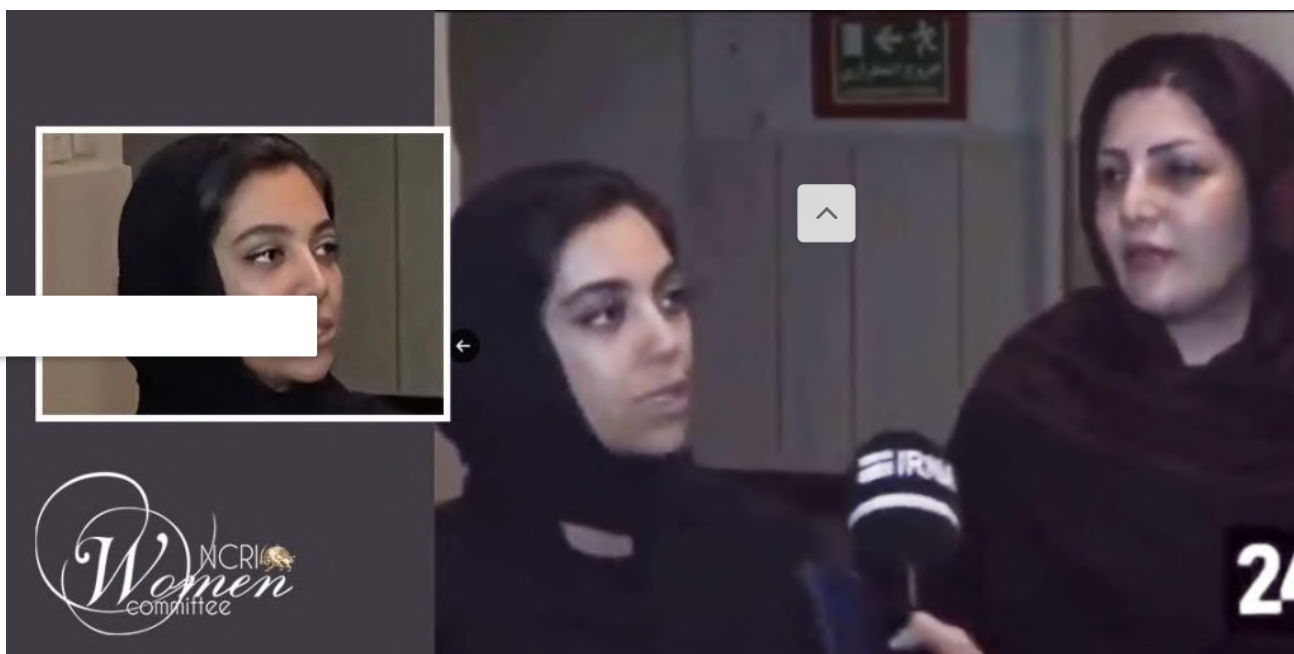
A created image from social media, depicting Armita's ordeal in the metro carriage

Another witness said Armita was still conscious when she fell on the ground. Witnesses claimed they spotted the same hijab enforcer waiting behind the ambulance that took Armita to the hospital.

State news has not carried any footage from inside the train itself and offered no explanation on why it hadn't been released. Most train cars on the Tehran metro have multiple CCTV cameras, which are viewable by security personnel. Opposition figures say the clock on the footage shows at least 100 seconds is missing.

Other reports on social media identified the woman accompanying the parents of the 16-year-old Armita Geravand, during their interview at the hospital as Kowsar Jowhari. She is a teacher at Hazrat-e Massoumeh School in Shahriar and a member of the Basij in this city. She is not in any way related to the Geravand family.

Amnesty International issued a call on Friday, October 6, urging an investigation of the conditions of Armita Geravand by an independent fact-finding mission while the Iranian government is only trying to cover up.

Let us all pray for the recovery of the innocent 16-year-old Armita Geravand as she is fighting for her life and symbolizing the fate of young Iranian women who want to enjoy their fundamental freedoms.

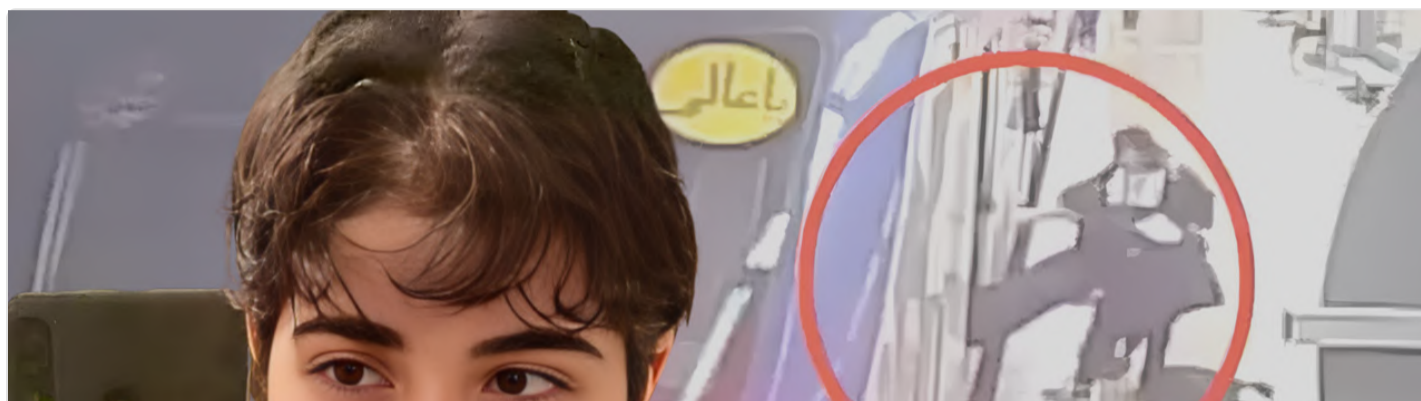

Armita Garawand, a 16-year-old girl, has been in a coma since Sunday, October 3rd, due to severe physical assault by the "Morality police officers in the Tehran Metro. She is currently under strict security measures at "Fajr" Air Force Hospital.

According to reports obtained by the Hengaw organization for Human Rights, on the morning of Sunday, October 1st, 2023, Armita Garawand, a 16-year-old originally from Kermanshah residing in Tehran, was physically attacked by authorities in the "Shohada" station at Tehran Metro for what they perceived as non-compliance with the compulsory "hijab". As a result, she sustained severe injuries and was transported to the hospital.

According to an informed source, due to the extensive presence of security forces at "Fajr Hospital", there are currently no visits allowed for the victim, not even for her family. A journalist who had visited this medical center to prepare a report was detained immediately by security forces. Maryam Lotfi, a detained journalist from "Shargh" newspaper, was subsequently released hours after the incident was published.

Ever Since the incident of Armita's situation has gone viral, all state-affiliated media outlets have systematically denied the physical assault on this young girl, and government officials have claimed that no physical altercation has taken place. These claims are solely based on a short, cropped video from an

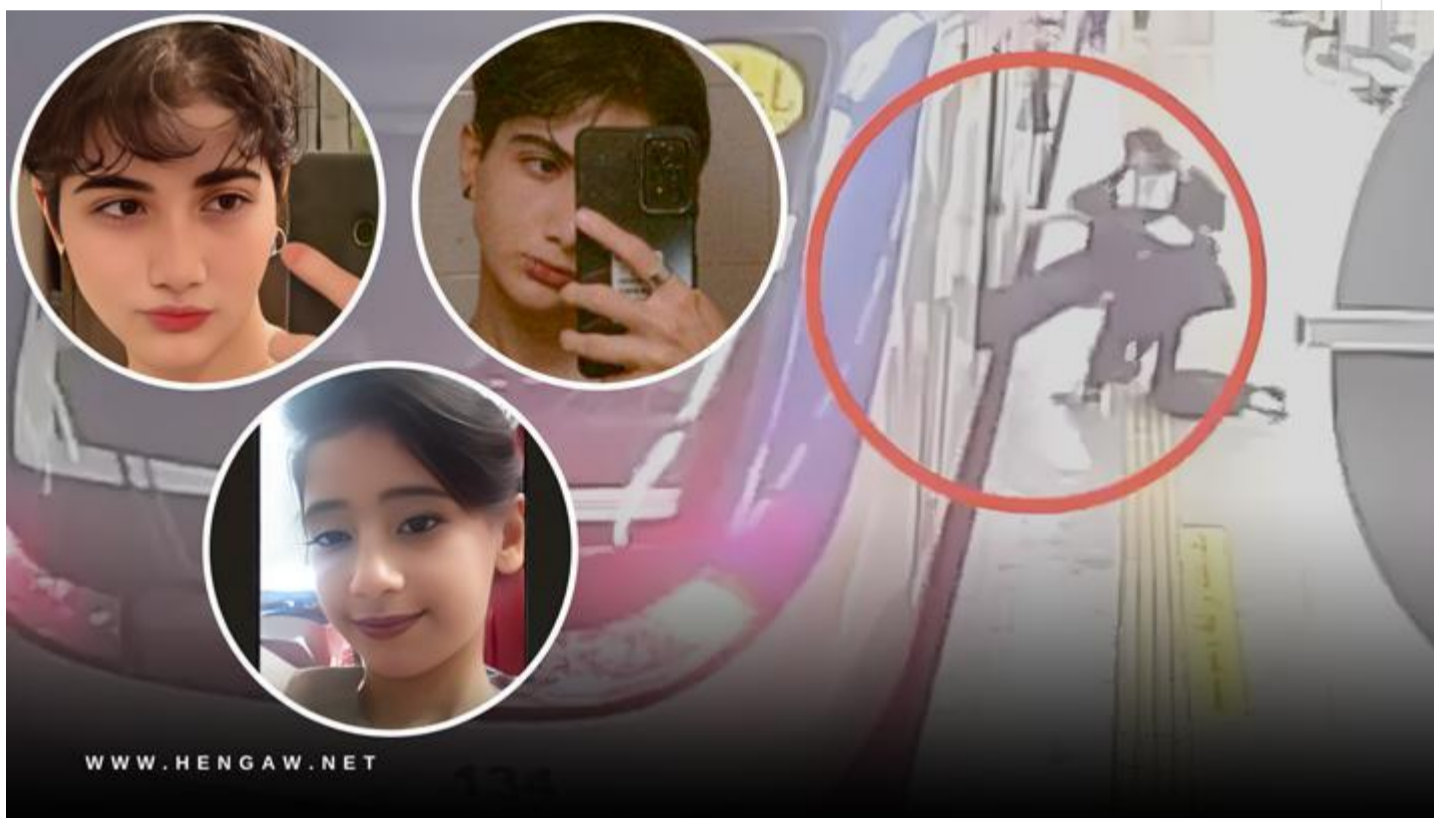

Moreover, state-run media, citing Tehran Metro authorities, claim that Armita Garawand has fainted due to low blood pressure. which, given the circumstances and heavy security presence at the hospital and the denial of visitation, has raised public concerns about the possibility of a recurrence of the Jina Amini scenario.

On the other hand, during the past two days, there has been no news from Armita Garawand's family, including her father, Bahman Garawand, and her mother, Shahin Ahmadi, indicating intense security control over the family to prevent any form of communication with the public.

Armita Gravand (born on April 13, 2005) is an Iranian citizen who was admitted to Fajr Hospital affiliated to the Army Medical Sciences University in a coma after an accident in the Tehran subway on 9 Mehr 1402. He is an 11th grade student at a conservatory in Tehran

It is unclear exactly what happened to Armita in the train car, but the circumstances have fueled accusations that Hijab officers may have harmed her. Some media, including Radio Farda , Guardian and Iranwire , have reported, quoting eyewitnesses, that shortly after Gravand entered the Tehran subway, one of the hijab-wearing women got into an argument with him about the mandatory hijab , and when Gravand resisted, the hijab wearer pushed her. and when his head hits a metal pillar, he faints. The media and officials of the Islamic Republic of Iran claim that there was no physical attack on him.

Life

Armita Gravand was born on April 13, 2005 ^[1] and according to the Human Rights Organization *Hengav* is a resident of Kermanshah . ^[2] He is a student of the 11th grade of Arwa Al-Wagghi State Conservatory in the 11th district of Tehran . ^[3] He is a martial artist and has a 3rd dan black belt in ^[4] . taekwondo

Metro accident

On Sunday, October 9, 1402, the news of Armita Gravand fainting in the Tehran subway was published for the first time. ^[5] Farzad Seifikaran, a journalist of Radio Zamane, reported Armita's story for the first time. It is unclear exactly what happened to Armita in the train ^[6] .car, but the circumstances have fueled accusations that Hijab officers may have harmed her

According to unofficial reports, a teenage girl along with her friends, while not wearing the mandatory hijab , got into a car at Shahada Square metro station and after being pushed by the officers, her head hit the metal pillar of the car and she fainted. ^[7] This report was later ^{[10][9][8]} .republished by Radio Farda , Guardian and Iranwire citing eyewitnesses

Government media in Iran have released several short videos to describe the incident from different angles. Parts of these videos have been edited and removed and do not show what may have caused him to fall inside the subway. ^[11] Also, it was limited to publishing the images outside the wagon and the video recorded by the cameras inside the wagon was not broadcast. According to state media, "train 134, which was carrying the unconscious student girl, was from the 100 series and had no camera." But on the other hand, a number of social media users, by comparing the image of the 100 series trains with the train published in the videos, have claimed that the train that was active on ^[12] .the day of the accident was from the 110 series and has an internal CCTV camera

In one of these videos, a girl enters the station without a headscarf and passes through the gate, then goes to the supermarket and shops, and finally gets on the subway car, and a few seconds later, she falls to the ground and is pulled out by her friends. Amnesty International has reviewed the video and found that the video has been edited in four parts and the number of frames has been increased. Also, according ^[13] .to the clock indicating the time of the video, 3 minutes and 16 seconds have been cut from the video

IRNA report

A day after the incident, IRNA news agency conducted an interview with Masoud Darshi, the managing director of Tehran Metro operation, who said that the 16-year-old girl " lost her balance and fell to the ground due to low blood pressure ." The managing director of Tehran ^[5] ."Metro emphasized that all "CCTV cameras have been reviewed and no conflict has been recorded

IRNA also published CCTV images from the moment the student and her friends entered, who were not wearing masks . Moments after boarding the subway train; one of them fell to the ground, and then with the help of his friends and another passenger, he was carried to the platform. CCTV images from the moment these three students entered Shahada metro station and before entering the train have not been ^[5] .published

IRNA also published a video of his mother and father ^[14] which according to some social media users and human rights groups is a " forced confession " . ^{[7][15]} While looking distressed, they hesitantly spoke of "pressure drop" and "hitting their daughter's head on the edge of the ^[5] ."train

In its reports, IRNA did not name Armita Ground and her parents and introduced her as a "hospitalized student".^[5] After two days of the incident, Hengav announced her identity as "Armita Gravand"^[2] and the Iranian state media named this girl as "Armita Gravand" for the ^[16].first time on Wednesday 12 Mehr

Radio report

On October 12, Sedava Sima , Iran's state television, published new images of Shahada station in a report, which does not include an image ^[16].of the inside of the car where the accident occurred. In these CCTV videos, Armita Ground is not wearing a scarf or mask

The report says that "at 7:08 AM, Armita gets on the subway with her friends, and four seconds later, she gets dizzy and turns back, hitting ^[16]".the edge of the subway." This report also says that "in his medical record, the cause of anesthesia is mentioned as pressure drop

In this report, Sedavasima also broadcast the conversations of two girls whose faces are blurred and who says they are Armita Ground's friends. The two girls say that Armita "suddenly fell from behind and hit the (distance between) the platform and the subway door" as soon ^[16].as she entered the subway car

Guardian report

On 13 Mehr, two eyewitnesses confirmed the "beating" of Armita Gravand "on the head of the hijab" in a conversation with the *Guardian newspaper*.^[9]^[17]^[18] At the beginning of 1402, Alireza Zakani , the mayor of Tehran , had announced that he had deployed a municipal security unit in Tehran metro stations for "heavy positive" work to deal with citizens who have problems and Prevent them from entering the ^[19].subway

According to one of the eyewitnesses, when Armita entered the subway car, she faced the warnings of a female hijab attendant , and this woman argued with her because Armita did not have a headscarf. According to this eyewitness, "the veiled woman shouted, why don't you ^[9]?"wear hijab?" And Armita replied, "Shall I tell you why you don't take off your tent

According to *the Guardian*, quoting this eyewitness, this verbal conflict later turned violent and the hijab wearer attacked Armita and pushed her hard. *The Guardian* report , quoting another eyewitness, said that "Armita was still conscious after falling to the ground." This eyewitness also told the *Guardian* , "The same hijab-wearing woman was standing next to the ambulance door when the Tehran emergency ^[9].department was taking Armita to the hospital

Hospital

After anesthesia, Armita was transferred to Fajr Air Force Hospital.^[7] The atmosphere around the hospital was secured after Armita was hospitalized ^[20] and the official news coverage of this event was limited to *IRNA* under strict security measures . In this situation, Maryam ^[23]^[22]^[21] .Lotfi , a reporter of Shargh newspaper who went to Fajr Air Force Hospital to get news, was detained for several hours

Due to the lack of access of independent journalists to the hospital where Armita is hospitalized, there is no documented information about her health condition, but the Iranwire website, citing its sources, reported that Armita Ground is in a coma, and the online newspaper *Faraz Daily* also reported in a news that after a few He removed the watch from his website, quoting Armita Ground's father, who wrote that she is ^[25].in a coma. ^[24]^[16] *Henggao* website first reported that Armita was in a coma

The publication of a picture of Armita Ground in the intensive care unit of Tehran's Fajr Hospital on social networks caused the pressure on her family to double, and the officers seized the cell phones of Armita's family members, who is still in a coma, on the suspicion of sending the picture. ^[26] Also, according to the Coordinating Council of Trade Union Organizations of Iran , Armita's teachers were threatened by the ^[16].security chief of the Ministry of Education to refrain from publishing any news or photos of him

On 12 Mehr, Radio Farda informs from an informed source at Kasab Hospital that Armita suffered " cerebral bleeding and bleeding in the skull" and "this is the reason for her low blood pressure and anesthesia". According to the report, Armita is "still in a coma," but the cause of ^[8].her coma has not been made clear

On the evening of Wednesday, Mehr 12th, Hahngao reported that Armita's mother, Shaheen Ahmadi, was "arrested and transferred to an unknown place" in Tehran's Fajr Hospital. At the same time, *Tasnim* news agency , close to the IRGC , denied the news of the arrest of Armita ^[27].Ground's mother

reactions

This incident and the conflicting explanations surrounding it are similar to the events before the killing of Mehsa Amini , who was arrested for not observing the mandatory hijab. ^[28] Ever since Armita's condition became publicized, all the government media of the Islamic Republic of Iran denied beating him in an organized manner and with the same text, and the government officials also claimed that there ^[29].was no physical attack

Several non-governmental media outlets in Iran were banned from following Armita's situation and publishing reports about her. ^[30] Referring to the "unreliability" of the state media, the newspaper *Hame Mihan* wrote that assuming the truth of Armita Ground's "pressure drop" narrative, "the question is why this narrative was not accepted by a group of people and the issue of her conflict with hijab wearers in ^[24]?' " .the subway was raised

The *Iran Watch* website has reported that the security forces of Tehran Municipality, known as Hijabban, have not been present in almost any of Tehran's metro stations since Monday, October 10. ^[24] Tehran municipality had hired a number of people as hijab wearers in the ^[31] subway since the middle of August 1402

Armita's fainting and going into a coma caused many international reactions and some political officials reacted about this issue. In contrast , Nasser Kanani , the spokesman of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Islamic Republic , called these reactions "interference" in the ^[32] internal affairs of his country

In a report , the *Guardian* discussed the doubts of public opinion and the possibility of repeating the tragedy of Gina (Mehsa) Amini. ^[33] Telegraph , ABC News , *Bild* , Spiegel and NTV are other media that addressed this issue

In a tweet, Reza Pahlavi wrote about this incident: "While the Iranian nation is still grieving and demanding the murder of #Mehsa_Amini, the news of #Armita_Gravand's coma at the hands of the hijab-wearing mob of the Islamic Republic is a confirmation once again that ^[34] ".despite this anti-Iranian regime, the lives of Iran's children It is in danger every day and every moment

While calling the behavior of the Islamic Republic intolerable, German Foreign Minister Analena Berbock wrote in a tweet: "Armita Ground's parents do not belong in front of the camera, they have the right to be present at their daughter's bedside." ^[35] Melanie Jolly , Canada's ^[32] foreign minister, said that the Islamic Republic continues to "oppress and despotize" and ignore its citizens

The Iranian Human Rights Organization demanded an independent investigation into the events that led to the injury of this 16-year-old girl. ^[36] Referring to the Islamic Republic's attempt to cover up the facts surrounding the conditions of Armita Ground, Amnesty International called for an independent international panel to investigate the situation. ^[37] At the same time, the UN fact-finding committee ^[38] on the repression of protesters in Iran announced that it was investigating Armita Ground

زادهٔ ۱۳ فروردین ۱۳۸۵ (۱۷ سال)

محل زندگی تهران

ملیت ایرانی

پیشه دانش‌آموز

آرمیتا گراوند (زادهٔ ۱۳ فروردین ۱۳۸۵) شهروند ایرانی است که در ۹ مهر ۱۴۰۲، پس از حادثه‌ای در متروی تهران بیهوش و در بیمارستان فجر، وابسته به دانشگاه علوم پزشکی آرتش، بستری شد و در کما است. وی دانش‌آموز کلاس یازدهم هنرستانی در تهران است.

اینکه دقیقاً چه اتفاقی برای آرمیتا در واگن قطار افتاده نامشخص است، اما شرایط به این اتهامات دامن زده‌است که مأموران حجاب به او آسیب رسانده باشند. برخی رسانه‌ها از جمله رادیو فردا، گاردین و ایران‌وایر، به نقل از شاهدان عینی گزارش داده‌اند که اندکی بعد از ورود گراوند به متروی تهران، یکی از زنان حجاب‌بان با او بر سر حجاب اجباری وارد مشاجره شده و با مقاومت گراوند، حجاب‌بان او را هل می‌دهد و با برخورد سرش به ستون فلزی، بیهوش می‌شود. رسانه‌ها و مقامات نظام جمهوری اسلامی ایران مدعی هستند که هیچ‌گونه برخورد فیزیکی با او صورت نگرفته‌است.

زندگی

آرمیتا گراوند متولد ۱۳ فروردین ۱۳۸۵^[۱] و به گفته سازمان حقوق بشری *هنگاو* از اهالی کرمانشاه است.^[۲] او دانش‌آموز کلاس یازدهم هنرستان دولتی عروه‌الوثقی در منطقه ۱۱ تهران است.^[۳] او ورزشکار زمی است و در *تکواندو* کمر بند مشکی دان ۳ دارد.^[۴]

حادثه مترو

یکشنبه ۹ مهر ۱۴۰۲، خبر بیهوش شدن آرمیتا گراوند در متروی تهران برای اولین بار منتشر شد.^[۵] فرزند سیفی‌کاران، روزنامه‌نگار رادیو زمانه اولین بار ماجرای آرمیتا را گزارش کرد. اینکه دقیقاً چه اتفاقی برای آرمیتا در واگن قطار افتاده نامشخص است، اما شرایط به این اتهامات دامن زده‌است که مأموران حجاب به او آسیب رسانده باشند.^[۶]

بر اساس گزارش‌های غیررسمی، یک دختر نوجوان به همراه دوستانش، در حالی که حجاب اجباری بر سر نداشت، در ایستگاه متروی میدان شهدا وارد واگن شده و در پی هل دادن مأموران، سرش به ستون فلزی واگن برخورد کرده و بیهوش شده‌است.^[۷] این گزارش بعداً توسط رادیو فردا، گاردین و ایران‌وایر به نقل از شاهدان عینی بازنشر شده‌است.^{[۸][۹][۱۰]}

رسانه‌های حکومتی در ایران تا کنون چند ویدیوی کوتاه منتشر کرده‌اند تا از زوایای مختلف حادثه رخ داده را تشریح کنند. بخش‌هایی از این ویدئوها ویراش و حذف شده‌است و نشان نمی‌دهد چه چیزی ممکن است داخل مترو باعث زمین‌خوردن او شده‌باشد.^[۱۱] همچنین به انتشار تصاویر بیرون از واگن اکتفا شده و ویدیوی ضبط شده توسط دوربین‌های داخل واگن پخش نشده‌است. به ادعای رسانه‌های حکومتی «قطار ۱۳۴ که حامل دختر دانش‌آموز بی‌هوش شده بوده، از سری ۱۰۰ و فاقد دوربین بوده‌است.» اما در مقابل، تعدادی از کاربران شبکه‌های اجتماعی با مقایسه تصویر قطارهای سری ۱۰۰ با قطاری که در ویدیوها منتشر شده، مدعی شده‌اند که قطاری که روز حادثه فعال بوده از سیری ۱۱۰ بوده و دارای دوربین مداربسته داخلی است.^[۱۲]

در یکی از این ویدئوها، دختری بدون روسری وارد ایستگاه شده و از گیت عبور می‌کند، سپس به سوپرمارکت رفته و خرید می‌کند و در نهایت سوار واگن مترو می‌شود و چند ثانیه بعد به زمین می‌افتد و دوستانش او را بیرون می‌کشند. عفو بین‌الملل این ویدیو را بررسی کرده و دریافته‌است که فیلم در چهار بخش ویرایش شده و تعداد فریم‌ها افزایش یافته‌است. همچنین بر اساس ساعت نشان‌دهنده زمان ویدیو، ۳ دقیقه و ۱۶ ثانیه از ویدیو بریده شده‌است.^[۱۳]

گزارش ایرنا

یک روز بعد از حادثه، خبرگزاری ایرنا مصاحبه‌ای با مسعود درستی، مدیر عامل بهره‌برداری مترو تهران انجام داد که گفته‌است این دختر ۱۶ ساله «به دلیل افت فشار خون، تعادل خود را از دست داده و زمین‌خورده‌است». مدیر عامل مترو تهران تأکید کرد که همه «دوربین‌های مداربسته بازبینی شده و هیچ درگیری‌ای ثبت و ضبط نشده» است.^[۵]

ایرنا همچنین تصاویر دوربین‌های مداربسته از لحظه ورود این دختر دانش‌آموز و دوستانش را که مقنعه به سر نداشتند منتشر کرد. لحظاتی بعد از سوار شدن به قطار مترو یکی از آنها به زمین خورد و سپس با کمک دوستان و یکی دیگر از مسافران به روی سکو منتقل شد. تصاویر دوربین‌های مداربسته از لحظه ورود این سه دانش‌آموز به ایستگاه مترو شهدا و قبل از ورود به قطار منتشر نشده‌است.^[۵]

ایرنا همچنین ویدیویی از مادر و پدر او منتشر کرد^[۱۴] که به تعبیر برخی کاربران رسانه‌های اجتماعی و گروه‌های حقوق بشر «اعتراف اجباری» است.^{[۷][۱۵]} آنها در حالی که مضطرب به نظر می‌رسند، با تردید از «افت فشار» و «اصابت سر دخترشان به لبه قطار» گفتند.^[۵]

ایرنا در گزارش‌هایش هیچ اسمی از آرمیتا گراوند و والدین او نیاورده و او را «دانش‌آموز بستری شده» معرفی می‌کند.^[۵] پس از گذشت دو روز از حادثه، هنگاو هویت او را «آرمیتا گراوند» اعلام کرد.^[۱] و رسانه‌های دولتی ایران روز چهارشنبه ۱۲ مهر برای اولین بار از این دختر به عنوان «آرمیتا گراوند» نام بردند.^[۱۶]

گزارش صدا و سیما

۱۲ مهر، صدا و سیما، تلویزیون دولتی ایران، در گزارشی تصاویر تازه‌ای از ایستگاه شهدا منتشر کرد که شامل تصویری از داخل واگن که حادثه در آن رخ داد نیست. در این ویدئوهای مداربسته آرمیتا گراوند روسری یا مقنعه به سر ندارد.^[۱۶]

این گزارش می‌گوید که «ساعت هفت و هشت دقیقه صبح آرمیتا با دوستانش سوار مترو می‌شود، و پس از چهار ثانیه سرش گیج می‌رود و به عقب برمی‌گردد و به لبه مترو می‌خورد.» این گزارش همچنین می‌گوید که «در پرونده پزشکی او علت بیهوشی افت فشار عنوان شده‌است.»^[۱۶]

صداوسیما در این گزارش همچنین صحبت‌های دو دختر که صورت آنها تار شده و می‌گویند دوستان آرمیتا گراوند هستند را پخش کرد. این دو دختر می‌گویند که آرمیتا به محض ورود به واگن مترو «ناگهان از پشت افتاد و سرش محکم برخورد کرد به (فاصله میان) سکو و در مترو».^[۱۶]

گزارش گاردین

۱۳ مهر، دو شاهد عینی در گفتگو با روزنامه‌گاردین «ضرب و شتم» آرمیتا گراوند «بر سر حجاب» را تأیید کردند.^{[۹][۱۷][۱۸]} در ابتدای سال ۱۴۰۲، علیرضا زاکانی، شهردار تهران، اعلام کرده بود که در ایستگاه‌های مترو تهران یگان حفاظت شهرداری برای کار «ایجابی سنگین» مستقر کرده تا با شهروندانی که از نظرها مشکل داشته باشند برخورد و از ورود آنها به مترو جلوگیری کنند.^[۱۹]

به گفته یکی از شاهدان عینی، آرمیتا به هنگام ورود به واگن مترو با تذکرات یک حجاب‌بان زن روبه‌رو می‌شود و این زن به دلیل آن که آرمیتا روسری نداشته با او مشاجره می‌کند. به گفته این شاهد عینی «زن چادری فریاد زد که چرا حجاب نداری؟» و آرمیتا در پاسخ گفت: «آیا من به تو می‌گویم چرا چادرت را بر نمی‌داری؟»^[۹]

به نوشته‌گاردین به نقل از این شاهد عینی، این درگیری لفظی بعداً به خشونت کشیده شد و حجاب‌بان زن، با حمله به آرمیتا او را به شدت هل داده‌است. گزارش گاردین به نقل از یک شاهد عینی دیگر هم حاکی است که «آرمیتا هنوز بعد از زمین‌خوردن همچنان به هوش بوده‌است.» این شاهد عینی همچنین به گاردین می‌گوید «همان زن حجاب‌بان، وقتی اورژانس تهران آرمیتا را به بیمارستان منتقل می‌کرد در کنار در آمبولانس ایستاده بود.»^[۹]

بیمارستان

آرمیتا پس از بیهوشی به بیمارستان فجر نیروی هوایی منتقل شد.^[۷] جو اطراف بیمارستان پس از بستری شدن آرمیتا در آن امنیتی شده بود.^[۲۰] و پوشش خبری رسمی این واقعه تحت تدابیر شدید امنیتی تنها در انحصار *ایرنا* قرار گرفت. در این شرایط مریم لطفی، خبرنگار روزنامه شرق که برای کسب خبر به بیمارستان فجر نیروی هوایی رفته بود، برای ساعاتی بازداشت شد.^{[۲۱][۲۲][۲۳]}

به دلیل دسترسی نداشتن خبرنگاران مستقل به بیمارستان محل بستری آرمیتا، اطلاعاتی مستندی از وضعیت سلامتی او وجود ندارد، اما وبگاه ایران‌وایر به نقل از منابع خود گزارش کرده‌است که آرمیتا گراوند در وضعیت کما است و روزنامه اینترنتی *فراز دبیلی* نیز در خبری که پس از چند ساعت از وبگاهش حذف کرد به نقل از پدر آرمیتا گراوند نوشته بود که او در کما است.^{[۲۴][۲۵]} اولین مرتبه وبگاه *هنگاو* گزارش کرد که آرمیتا در کما است.^[۲۵]

انتشار تصویری از آرمیتا گراوند در بخش مراقبت‌های ویژه بیمارستان فجر تهران در شبکه‌ها اجتماعی سبب شد که فشار بر خانواده او دوچندان شود و مأموران گوی‌های همراه اعضای خانواده آرمیتا را که همچنان در کما به سر می‌برد به ظن ارسال تصویر، ضبط کنند.^[۲۶] همچنین به گزارش شورای هماهنگی تشکل‌های صنفی فرهنگیان ایران، معلمان آرمیتا توسط رئیس حراست وزارت آموزش و پرورش تهدید شدند که از انتشار هرگونه خبر یا عکسی از او خودداری کنند.^[۲۶]

۱۲ مهر، رادیو فردا از یک منبع مطلع در بیمارستان کسب اطلاع می‌کند که آرمیتا دچار «خونریزی مغزی و خونریزی در جمجمه» شده و «دلیل افت فشار و بیهوشی او همین مسئله است.» بر اساس این گزارش، آرمیتا «همچنان در کما به سر می‌برد»، اما در مورد علت به کما رفتن او به‌طور شفاف اطلاع‌رسانی نمی‌شود.^[۸]

هنگاو، عصر روز چهارشنبه ۱۲ مهر گزارش کرد شهین احمدی، مادر آرمیتا، در محوطه بیمارستان فجر تهران «بازداشت و به مکان نامعلومی منتقل» شده‌است. هم‌زمان خبرگزاری تسنیم، نزدیک به سپاه پاسداران، خبر بازداشت مادر آرمیتا گراوند را تکذیب کرد.^[۲۷]

واکنش‌ها

این حادثه و توضیحات ضد و نقیض پیرامون آن، شباهت‌هایی به وقایع قبل از کشته‌شدن مهسا امینی دارد که به دلیل رعایت نکردن حجاب اجباری دستگیر شده بود.^[۲۸] از زمان رسانه‌ای شدن وضعیت آرمیتا تمامی رسانه‌های حکومتی نظام جمهوری اسلامی ایران به صورت سازمان‌یافته و با متنی یکسان ضرب و شتم او را تکذیب و مقامات حکومتی نیز مدعی شدند که هیچ‌گونه برخورد فیزیکی صورت نگرفته‌است.^[۲۹]

چند رسانه غیردولتی در ایران از پیگیری وضعیت آرمیتا و انتشار گزارش دربارهٔ او منع شدند.^[۳۰] روزنامه *هم‌میهن* با اشاره به «بی‌اعتباری» رسانه‌های دولتی نوشته‌است که با فرض صحت روایت «افت فشار» آرمیتا گراوند، «سؤال اینجاست که چرا این روایت مورد پذیرش گروهی از مردم قرار نگرفته و مسئله درگیری او با حجاب‌بان‌های درون مترو مطرح شده‌است؟»^[۲۴]

وبگاه *دیدهبان ایران* گزارش داده‌است که نیروهای انتظامات شهرداری تهران موسوم به حجاب‌بان از دوشنبه ۱۰ مهر در تقریباً هیچ‌کدام از ایستگاه‌های مترو تهران حضور نداشته‌اند.^[۲۴] شهرداری تهران از اواسط مرداد ۱۴۰۲ تعدادی نیرو را به عنوان حجاب‌بان در مترو استخدام کرده بود.^[۳۱]

بیهوش شدن و به کما رفتن آرمیتا، واکنش‌های بین‌المللی زیادی به دنبال داشته و برخی از مقامات سیاسی دربارهٔ این موضوع واکنش نشان دادند. در مقابل ناصر کنعانی، سخنگوی وزارت خارجه جمهوری اسلامی، این واکنش‌ها را «مداخله» در امور داخلی کشورش عنوان کرد.^[۳۲]

گاردین در گزارشی به تردیدهای افکار عمومی و امکان تکرار فاجعه ژینا (مهسا) امینی پرداخت. *تلگراف*، *ای‌بی‌سی نیوز*، *بیلد*، *اشپیکل* و *ان‌تی‌وی* رسانه‌های دیگری هستند که به این موضوع پرداختند.^[۲۳]

رضا پهلوی در تویییتی نسبت به این اتفاق نوشت: «در حالی که ملت ایران همچنان داغدار و دادخواه قتل #مهسا امینی است، خبر به کما رفتن #آرمیتا گراوند به دست اوباش حجاب‌بان جمهوری اسلامی تأیید دگرباره‌ای ست بر اینکه با وجود این رژیم ضدایرانی، جان فرزندان ایران هر روز و هر لحظه در خطر است.»^[۳۳]

آنالینا بریوک وزیر خارجه آلمان، ضمن غیرقابل تحمل خواندن رفتار جمهوری اسلامی، در تویییتی نوشت: «جای والدین آرمیتا گراوند روبروی دوربین نیست، آن‌ها حق دارند بر بالین دخترشان حاضر باشند.»^[۳۵] ملانی جولی، وزیر خارجه کانادا، گفت است که جمهوری اسلامی همچنان به «ظلم و خودکامگی» و بی‌توجهی به شهروندان خود ادامه می‌دهد.^[۳۲]

سازمان حقوق بشر ایران خواستار تحقیق مستقل درخصوص اتفاقاتی شد که به آسیب‌دیدگی این دختر ۱۶ ساله منجر شده‌است.^[۳۶] عفو بین‌الملل با اشاره به تلاش جمهوری اسلامی در سرپوش‌گذاشتن بر حقایق پیرامون شرایط آرمیتا گراوند، خواستار بررسی وضعیت از سوی یک هیئت مستقل بین‌المللی شد.^[۳۷] همزمان کمیته حقیقت‌یاب سازمان ملل در مورد سرکوب معترضان در ایران اعلام کرد در مورد آرمیتا گراوند تحقیق می‌کند.^[۳۸]
