The "ambiguous" death of a citizen from Khorram Abad in Tehran's intelligence department



The police force of the Islamic Republic arrested Iman Hassanvand on the charge of "committing violent crimes".

Human rights media say that Iman Hassanvand, the defendant from Khorramabad, died in the detention center of Tehran's Intelligence Department in a "mysterious" manner.

Harana Human Rights News Agency wrote on Sunday, January 24, that Mr. Hassanvand was "shot and seriously injured" when he was arrested on September 30 this year.

This news agency wrote that he and some of his relatives "were ambushed by Tehran police officers who were chasing them four months ago".

According to this report, Iman Hassanvand "along with a number of other people, mainly from Khorramabad, were accused of committing violent crimes".

The human rights news agency Hahngao also wrote in this regard that Majid Rezaei, another wanted suspect, during this arrest, "while trying to escape, was shot in the head by the direct fire of these forces and was killed instantly".

According to the report of the police force, on June 1 this year, another person close to these two citizens, named Iman Hemti, was killed "with baton blows and a direct shot .to the head

Harana News Agency has written that in 2013, the police chief of Lorestan province informed the media about the previous arrest of Mr. Hasanvand and his relatives .under the title of "vampire gang" on charges of "armed robbery" and "murder

In addition to "ordinary crimes" prisoners, political and ideological prisoners have also lost their lives during detention due to lack of medical treatment, injury during .detention, and torture

In this context, on July 19 this year, human rights activists announced the death of Peyman Galwani, a Kurdish political prisoner from Mahabad, as a result of torture in .the detention center of the Urmia Intelligence Department

The announcement of the death of Peyman Galwani a few days after his arrest and transfer to the Urmia Detention Center, a day after that, it was announced that human rights activists on Saturday, July 18, reported the death of Musa Ismaili, a Kurdish political prisoner from Piranshahr, under "torture by security forces."
